Secretary's Report: There was no new business to report. The March meeting minutes were approved.

We will have access to the venue on Saturday from 12 noon until after the event. Kelley asked for members to help out as much as they could before the event.

Administration Report:

The students in grades K4-8 will be taking Achievement Tests next week. Debbie suggested that the children not schedule appointments and eat a good breakfast during the week of testing.

A donor has graciously offered to complete the pavilion with tables and umbrellas so the children will be covered during the heat of the school year.

The PTL can talk to Mr. Rath about getting the \$6500 we donated back to use it toward a different project.
